

TRI-STATE CLASSICS

22 *Spring Valley Farm Walk-Trot Open Pleasure Classic:* A walk-trot only classic open to horses or ponies and riders of any age, who have never competed in any class at any show requiring a canter. *Green horses are not eligible to be ridden in this classic.* **Exhibitors must be a member of Tri-State.**

23 *Prospect Hill Farm Open Equitation Classic:* A Walk-Trot-Canter equitation classic open to all disciplines and open to riders of any age on horses or ponies. This will be judged as a 2-phase class. The 1st phase will consist of rail work. The judge will select 8-10 riders to complete a pattern of the judge's choosing for the 2nd phase. The pattern **will not be posted.** **Exhibitors must be a member of Tri-State.**

42 *C&M Farms Open Hunter Pleasure Classic:* Open to all exhibitors riding hunt seat, except Walk-Trot riders. Open to horses and ponies. Exhibitors will be asked to walk, trot, and canter both directions of the ring. Extension may be asked for at the judge's discretion. **Exhibitors must be a member of Tri-State.**

111 *Cornerstone Farm Open Pleasure Classic:* A walk-trot-canter class open to all exhibitors in all disciplines, except Walk-Trot riders. Open to horses and ponies. **Exhibitors must be a member of Tri-State.**

112 *Checker Board Stables Pro-Am Walk-Trot Equitation Classic:* Open to Walk-Trot riders of any age and Professionals age 18 & over in all disciplines. No person, EXCEPT THE PROFESSIONALS, entering any class requiring a canter will be eligible for this classic. This class will be judged on equitation. This is a two-rider class. The professional will ride the first way of the ring, while the amateur remains in the middle. A change of rider will then take place in the ring, and the amateur will ride the second way of the ring. Professionals may be asked to perform a simple test such as dropping the stirrups, western riders posting, English riders sitting, etc. in addition to normal Walk-Trot rail work. The professional will remain in the middle of the ring while the amateur rides. No communication is allowed at any point while in the ring. Awards will be given to both the professional and the amateur. This class will be double judged by the judges from both rings, with classes in one ring being suspended while this class is run. One rider must be a professional and the other must be a Walk-Trot rider. **Exhibitors must be a member of Tri-State.**

174 *Pro-Am Open Pleasure Classic:* Open to all exhibitors in all disciplines, except Walk-Trot riders. Professionals must be age 18 & over. This is a two-rider class. The professional will ride the first way of the ring, while the amateur remains in the middle. A change of rider will then take place in the ring, and the amateur will ride the second way of the ring. The professional will remain in the middle of the ring while the amateur rides. No communication is allowed at any point while in the ring. Awards will be given to both the professional and the amateur. This class will be double judged by the judges from both rings, with classes in one ring being suspended while this class is run. One rider must be a professional and the other must be an amateur. **Exhibitors must be a member of Tri-State.**

175 *Rocky Meadow Farm Non-Pro Team Open Pleasure Classic:* This is a canter/lope classic open to all NON PROFESSIONAL exhibitors of any age in all disciplines. This is a two-rider class. One rider will ride the first way of the ring while the second rider remains in the middle of the ring. A change of rider will then take place in the ring, and the second rider will ride the second way of the ring. No communication is allowed during the rider change from inside or outside of the arena. The first rider will remain in the middle of the ring while the seconds rides. Awards will be given to both riders. This class will be double judged by the judges from both rings, with classes in one ring being suspended while this class is run. **Exhibitors must be a member of Tri-State.**
