**55** Windy Ridge "Gambler's Choice" Jumper Stake: Open to riders of all ages. **Rookie Jumpers and Crossrail riders are ineligible for this class, but all other riders are eligible regardless of heights jumped in other divisions.** Open to horses and ponies. Course to consist of jumps ranging in height from 2'0" to 2'6". All obstacles will be assigned a point value based on difficulty. Each rider will be allowed 60 seconds to jump as many obstacles as possible, in no set order. No obstacle may be jumped more than three times in a round nor can any obstacle be jumped in consecutive order. The horse/rider combination with the most points will be determined as the winner. In the event of a tie, there will be a ride-off. **Only the top three exhibitors will be pinned. Winners will be paid in cash! (1<sup>st</sup> place=\$50, 2<sup>nd</sup> place=\$30, 3<sup>rd</sup> place=\$20) Exhibitors must be a member of Tri-State.**

**89** Turn-N-Burn 3-Barrel Stake: Open to horses and ponies and riders of all ages. **The top three exhibitors will be pinned. Winners will be paid in cash! (1<sup>st</sup> place=\$50, 2<sup>nd</sup> place=\$30, 3<sup>rd</sup> place=\$20) Exhibitors must be a member of Tri-State. GYMKHANA DIVISIONS

**Personal Appointments and Tack:** Western-type long sleeved shirt, western pants or blue jeans, western-type hat or ASTM approved helmet with harness; hard boots with heels are all required. Chaps and/or spurs are optional. English attire allowed for Walk-Trot and Youth Divisions only. **Riders 17 and under must wear an ASTM approved helmet with a harness when mounted.** Western-style saddle and headstall (tapaderos prohibited). The following are allowed: bosal and/or hackamore, nosebands, martingales (**English Walk-Trot or Youth riders ONLY**) and/or tie-downs, protective leg bandages or boots, riding bats.

**Timing:** To be done by electric timer. Failure of electrical device would result in one person taking time by stopwatch. Timer located at the start/finish line.

**Restrictions/Disqualification:** Running starts prior to the first set of cones. Excessive use of whip/bat or spurs on any horse or pony in or out of ring, not following the pattern, fall of horse and/or rider, or unsoundness of horse or pony in or out of the ring will result in disqualification. **You must cross the starting line within two (2) minutes after your number is called to ride, or you will be disqualified.**

**Walk-Trot Gymkhana Division:** Open to horses and ponies. Open to **Walk-Trot** riders of any age who have not competed at any show, in any class, requiring a canter. Riders may only cross enter into other Walk-Trot classes. **Open to any discipline. Riders must use appropriate tack/attire for their discipline.**

## OPEN DRIVING DIVISION

This division is open to horses and ponies. Drivers that are age 14 and under must be accompanied by an adult. **Removal of the bridle while the horse/pony is between the shafts while in the ring means instant elimination.** The harness and cart/carriage must be in safe condition. Bridles must have a noseband or cavesson. **Classes will be split at the discretion of the show management.**

**Turnout:** Judged primarily on performance and quality of each turnout. To be judged: 70% on the condition, fit, and appropriateness of harness and vehicle, neatness and appearance of the attire and overall impression; 30% on performance, manners, and way of going.

**Pleasure:** Judged primarily on the suitability of the horse/pony to provide a pleasant drive. To be judged 70% on performance, manners and way of going; 20% on the condition and fit of the harness and cart/carriage; and 10% on neatness of attire.

## WESTERN DIVISIONS

**Personal Appointments:** Long-sleeved western-style shirt or appropriate blouse or long-sleeve shirt with collar, band, stand-up or tuxedo-style, Western hat or approved ASTM helmet with harness and boots with heel are required. Western-type chaps are optional. Riders opting not to wear chaps must wear trousers or show pants. Spurs are optional.

**Tack:** Stock-type saddle required. Any lariat, riata or hobbles are optional. Covered stirrups are prohibited. Western-type headstall required. Cavesson-type nosebands are prohibited. No discrimination against any standard western bit (i.e. curb-type with shanks, solid or broken mouthpiece). Horses five years and under using a ring snaffle bit or bosal/hackamore may be ridden with two hands. Horses six years and over must be ridden with one hand in a shank-type bit. Mechanical hackamores are prohibited. Bosals are allowed as appropriate to breed and age of horse. Curb strap or chain chin strap must be at least ½" in width and be of the standard flat variety. No wire or metal other than approved type curb chains allowed. Rounded, rolled, braided or rawhide curb straps are prohibited. Reins may be of split leather variety or romal reins. Breastplate is optional. Nosebands, martingales, tie-downs or draw reins are prohibited. Bandages and/or boots of any type are prohibited.

**Friday Open Western Division:** Open to horses and ponies. Open to all riders of any age.

**Discipline Rail classes will be judged on the quality of execution of the commands given. The horse's willingness, responsiveness, and smoothness will be taken into consideration. Commands may include, but are not limited to, transitions, lateral movements, and extended gaits.**

## LEAD-LINE DIVISIONS

**Requirements:** Open to riders 7 years of age and under who have never competed in any riding class other than Lead-Line. Open to all disciplines. Riders are required to direct their own mounts in all classes. Handler's interference will be penalized. No covered stirrups allowed. A halter under or over the bridle is **mandatory** for all classes. Handler must be 14 years or over and dressed in neat, appropriate attire. Diagonals will not count in equitation for hunt seat riders. Position of free hand will not count in equitation for western riders. Side walkers are allowed without penalty for exhibitors 3 years of age and under. Grab straps are permitted, but usage is subject to penalty at the discretion of the judge. For personal appointments and tack requirements, see the descriptions under Hunt Seat, Saddleseat, and Western divisions, as applicable to your discipline. **No Green Horses will be allowed in Lead Line classes.**

There will be no ride-offs or coin toss for any ties that occur for any Day-End Division Championships. Any Day-End Division tie will be broken by one of the following methods, as applicable, by the Show Manager:

- *Barrel Time*
- *Most points over Fences*
- *Halter Class in the Registered Breed Divisions*
- *Equitation/Horsemanship in other Divisions*
- *A tie-breaker class will be selected in Divisions without one of the above tie-breaker methods.*
- ***There will be no tie-breaks for Reserve Champion. Multiple Reserve Champion placings will be awarded as applicable.***

## HUNT SEAT DIVISIONS

The hunter course is closed to everyone except during specified warm-up times. Any horse and/or person jumping any fence outside of the designated warm-up times will be escorted out of the ring, disqualified and prohibited from exhibiting in any over fence class. No alterations to any posted course without prior authorization from both the Show Steward and judge will be allowed.

**Personal Appointments:** Riders 17 and under must wear an ASTM approved helmet with a harness when mounted. Riders 18 and over must wear an ASTM approved helmet with a harness when jumping. **Helmet regulations will be enforced.** Suitable Hunt shirt should be worn under hunt jacket. Removal of jackets is at the discretion of the judge. No sleeveless riding shirts will be allowed if the judge makes jackets optional. Breeches or jodhpurs, riding boots with heel are required. Chaps are not allowed. Half chap systems are allowed with approval from show management. Spurs are optional and must be of un-rowelled type. Crops or bats are optional.

**Tack:** Hunt-type saddle, hunter-type headstall with appropriate nose cavesson. Hackamore and/or bosals are prohibited. A chain chinstrap must be of standard flat variety. Judge may ask for removal/alteration of any bit deemed unfair/inhumane. Breastplate or cruppers are optional. Standing martingales are allowed in over fence classes only. Draw reins and/or dropped nosebands are prohibited. Bandages and/or boots on horse's legs are permitted in equitation classes only.

**Elimination:** The following will result in elimination: unsoundness of horse, jumping an obstacle before it is reset, bolting from the ring, off course, fall of horse or rider, or three refusals.

# JUMPERS

**Personal Appointments:** All riders must wear an ASTM approved helmet with a harness when jumping. **Helmet regulations will be enforced.** Hunt shirt and hunt jacket or polo shirt. No sleeveless shirts. Breeches or jodhpurs, and riding boots with heel are required. Half chaps are allowed. Spurs are optional and must be of unrowelled type. Crops or bats are optional.

**Tack:** Hunt-type saddle, hunter-type headstall with standard cavesson, dropped noseband, flash noseband or figure 8 noseband. Hackamores are permitted. Breastplate or cruppers are optional. Standing and running martingales are permitted. Draw reins and/or German martingales are prohibited. Bandages and/or boots on horse's legs are permitted.

**Elimination:** Unsoundness of horse, jumping an obstacle before it is reset, bolting from the ring, off course, fall of horse or rider or **THREE** refusals.

An "**Order of Go**" will be randomly generated by computer. A class closes when the first horse is on course. **Jumping out of order is considered grounds for elimination.**

**Rookie Jumper Division:** Open to riders in their first year of showing Jumpers ONLY. To be shown over 8 to 12 fences. Open to riders of any age. Open to horses and ponies. Fences not to exceed 2'0".

**197 Try the Canter (AUGUST SHOW ONLY):** Open to Walk-Trot riders who rode in a Walk-Trot age group Division at a prior TSHA show this year. (Green Horse or Novice Walk-Trot Divisions are not eligible). Riders must try the canter when asked. Limit of 8 riders will be asked to canter at a time. **There is a 2-year limit to participate in this class, after which the rider must move to Walk-Trot-Canter.** Participation in this class does not penalize riders who return to TSHA Walk-Trot Divisions.

## OPEN TRAIL DIVISION

**All classes in this Division will require a walk and trot only.** This division is open to riders of any age or discipline. The trail division consists of the following 3 separately judged classes. Trail courses will be available in the Show Office on the morning of the Trail classes, as well as posted at the trail ring. Please refer to appropriate division descriptions in the program for personal and tack appointments.

The trail ring will be open from 7:30-8:00 AM on Sunday morning for a course walk. **NO HORSE WILL BE ALLOWED ON THE COURSE DURING THE WALK-THROUGH.** Any horse and/or person entering the course prior to the start of judging on Sunday morning will be disqualified and prohibited from exhibiting in any trail class, and no refund will be issued. You must show an attempt at every obstacle in your trail course. After three attempts have been made at any obstacle, the rider will be asked to move on by the judge.

Elimination of any horse and rider will result from: Any horse/pony and person entering the course prior to the appointed time; fall of horse/pony and/or rider; unsoundness of horse/pony; bolting from the ring or course; or going off course.

**IMPORTANT:** Numbers will not be taken after 1:00 PM.  
Please complete your trail courses as early as possible during the day.

**Class 198 - Combination Trail:** In this class the course will consist of 6-8 obstacles, with equal amount of obstacles from the Real Trail and from the Traditional Show Trail.

**Class 199 - Real Trail:** In this class the course will consist of 6 natural obstacles (brush, logs, water, etc.). Exhibitors may be asked to dismount, but will not be asked to remount.

**Class 200 - Traditional Show Trail:** In this class the course will consist of 5-8 obstacles. The obstacles will be of the technical type, for example: side-pass, turns on the forehand and/or haunches, ground poles raised and/or flat, bridges, gates, mailboxes, back-ups. Any of the obstacles may be natural or painted.

## IN-HAND DIVISION

**Requirements:** Headstall with throatlatch or appropriate halter of the breed is required. Neat, appropriate attire for any In-Hand class is required. Horses or ponies are to be shown in-hand at walk and trot and to 'set-up' according to breed standards.

**Showmanship:** Open to horses and ponies. Judged strictly on the exhibitor's ability to show a horse or pony at halter. The horse or pony is merely a prop to demonstrate the ability of the exhibitor. The ideal showmanship performance consists of a poised, confident, neatly attired exhibitor leading a well-groomed horse that quickly and efficiently performs any requested pattern with promptness, smoothness and precision.

**Open Model Horse Classes:** Open to horses and ponies. To be judged on conformation, quality, substance and way of going, disposition, manners, and presentation of horse.

Horse or pony will be evaluated on responsiveness, willingness, and general attitude.

## SADDLESEAT DIVISION

**Personal Appointments:** Derby, soft hat or ASTM approved helmet with harness to be worn over confined hair. Hair must not cover the rider's number. Saddlesuit or jodhpur pants with day coat (day coat not to be penalized in equitation classes), shirt, tie, vest and jodhpur boots required. Gloves should be worn in all classes and are required in equitation. Whips are optional and should be less than 3'6" long. Optional spurs are to be of the unrowelled type.

**Tack:** Flat-type saddle with appropriate girth. Headstall: colored brow band or cavesson set with single or double bit and double reins. Bell boots, bandages or martingales are prohibited.
